2. Systems Update - Since the appointment of Marc Comeau, several advances have been made in support of the services that the Library provides. We'll have a review of these advances from Marc Comeau as well as discussion of short and mid-term priorities for the Systems Group.

Several initiatives, such as increased number of online tutorials, a much improved Web presence and several space improvements are in place based on the 2007 raw data. As discussed by the LIBQUAL planning committee through the summer of 2007, it would be very helpful now to explore how these "post-LIBQUAL" initiatives are being received by our user groups **before** the next LIBQUAL survey is conducted.
