The **Robert Maclellan Scholarship** of \$150, to be awarded to the student ranking highest in first-class standing in the second year of the four years' advanced course in Classics.

First, Second and Third Year Scholarships. These Scholarships vary from \$255 to \$100, and are awarded on the results of the University examinations of the respective years.

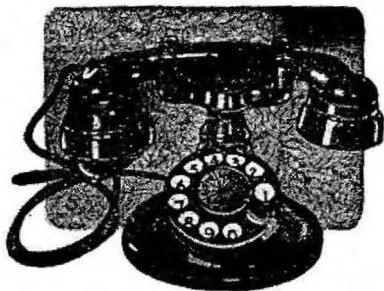

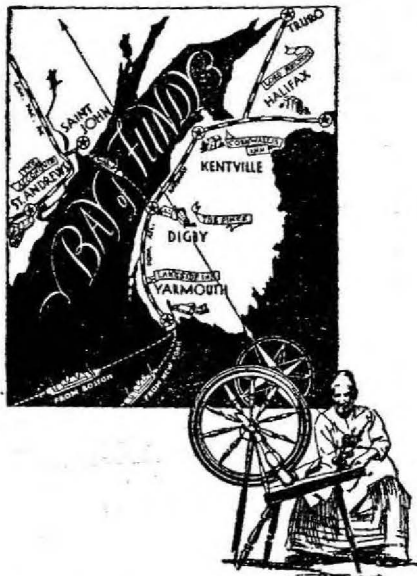
