

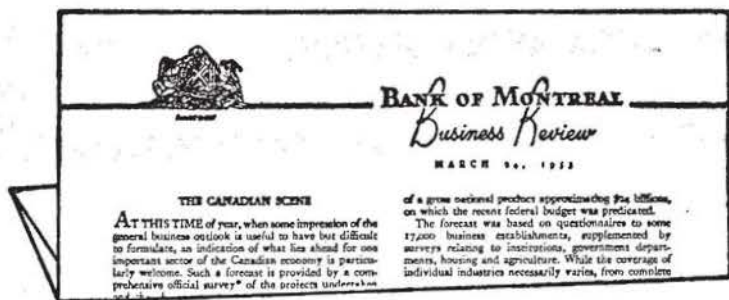
SEA - GOSSIP
