Footnotes should be numbered consecutively and typed together at the end of the article. Articles on floppy disk, particularly those using IBM and IBM-compatible systems with WordPerfect, are preferred. Other systems are often acceptable. Material submitted on diskette should be accompanied by hardcopy. Return of diskettes and manuscripts cannot be expected unless accompanied by a self-addressed envelope and return postage in Canadian stamps or International Reply Coupons.
