Leonard Holland, M.D., former member of the Dalhousie Faculty of Medicine, died in Halifax on March 23, 2003. He was 94.

Born in Halifax, he graduated from Dalhousie with degrees in science and medicine. Following his education, he pursued postgraduate training in eye, ear, nose and throat surgery in Montreal, Oregon and New York. After serving in World War II, he returned to Halifax where he established an eye, ear, nose and throat practice. He was a member of the medical staff of the former Victoria General Hospital and the Halifax Infirmary. For many years, he was head of the Eye Department at Camp Hill Hospital. He was also a faculty member at Dalhousie Medical School.

He is survived by two nephews. A memorial service is planned for a later date.
