1) Dalhousie University Libraries Web page assessment - Amir Feridooni

A go-forward model to provide a home for the Digital Initiative Group proposals and projects, based on existing software and expertise currently available to us, will be outlined.

4) Killam Learning Commons Reference Librarian / Navigator Pilot Project - Sharon Longard, Amir Feridooni, Michelle Paon

As discussed at the last PSAC meeting, Sharon Longard, Michelle Paon and Amir Feridooni, in collaboration with all Reference and Technical Support service providers at the Killam Library, have conducted a pilot project to determine whether the co-location of technical support and reference services at a single desk would enhance service to users.
