

GRAND MANAN ISLAND—On Swallow Tail Point, N E side of the island. A white fixed light, 148 feet above high water, visible 17 miles. Building white, Lat $44^{\circ} 45' 22''$ N. Long $66^{\circ} 44' 4''$ W. This is a conspicuous mark in the S Channel between Brier Island and Grand Manan.

GANNET ROCK—The Gannet Rock is 66 feet above high water, and has a light house upon it, painted black and white, in vertical stripes. A revolving light (visible 12 miles), lies S W by S distant $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles from the southern point of Three Islands, and S S E $\frac{1}{2}$ E 7 miles from the S W head of the Grand Manan. A gun is fired to answer signals during a fog. There are a number of small ledges and sunken rocks about it, which are always breaking. The light stands conspicuously in the immediate vicinity of all the sunken rocks and dangers, extending from the old Proprietor to the Seal Islands of Machias, a distance of about 20 miles. Between the northernmost and southernmost of the Murr Ledges there is a range of dangerous rocks and shoals, many of them above water, and which extend westward from the light house about 4 miles. From this range farther westerly, about six miles, lies a dangerous breaker, called the Bull. This may be avoided by keeping three remarkable headlands, near the S W end of Grand Manan, open.

CAMPO BELLO—On the N E extremity of the island. A white fixed light, 64 ft. above the sea, visible 15 miles. Building white with a red cross. This light enables vessels to enter Head Harbor at all times. It is also a guide to vessels entering the main channel, to West Isles, Moose Island, and the inner Bay of Passamaquoddy.

POINT LE PREAU—Upon this projecting head land two fixed white lights, one above the other, distant 28 feet. The lower lantern is fixed to the outside of the building, and throws its light quite inshore, both to the eastward and westward into Mace's Bay. The highest light is 81 feet, visible 15 miles. Building red and white in horizontal stripes, 5 ft broad, and bears from the easternmost Wolves E by N, 11 miles.

ST JOHN, N B. HARBOR—On Patridge Island at the entrance of the river and harbor. A white fixed light, 120 feet above high water, and visible 20 miles. Building red and white in vertical stripes. A Steam Whistle is sounded 10 seconds in every minute during fog and snow storms, audible 4 to 6 miles. There is also a BELL BUOY at the extremity of the ledge at the eastern end of the island, which is very useful to vessels in thick or rough weather. The bell can be heard 3 miles.

QUACO HEAD—On a small rock lying off Quaco Head. A revolving white light, 58 feet above high water, showing twice full and twice dark in a minute, visible 15 miles. Building red and white in horizontal stripes.

CAPE ENRAGE—On the point of that name in Westmorland nearly opposite Apple River Light in Cumberland. A plain white light, 151 feet above the sea, visible 15 miles. Square white building.

GRINDSTONE ISLAND—On Grindstone Island, Chignecto Bay. Lat $45^{\circ} 43' 13''$ N. Long $64^{\circ} 37' 25''$ W. 60 feet above high water. Octagonal white tower.
