Other Entrance Scholarships. Nine valuable scholarships of value from \$300 to \$100, awarded on results of the matriculation examinations held in September of each year; one each is reserved for Halifax County, Cape Breton Island, New Brunswick and Prince Edward Island.

Special \$200 Scholarships awarded to Pictou Academy, Prince of Wales College, and Memorial University College, St. John's, Newfoundland.

First, Second and Third Year Scholarships: These scholarships vary from \$255 to \$100, and are awarded on the results of the University examinations of the respective years.
