Professional Development for Intern Supervisors

LIPCC hosted a professional development workshop for intern supervisors on February 18, 2021. This informal session included discussions around intern supervision and a selection of Percipio training modules completed by the group.

The membership agreed that more opportunities for such discussions would be beneficial in the future. As a result, supervisor check-ins were scheduled throughout the summer to discuss projects and intern progress.

SIM 100-hr Practicum Proposals Drop-In Session

On October 26, 2020, Sarah Stevenson and Sarah Jane Dooley offered a drop-in session for anyone interested in submitting a proposal for the 100-hr practicum. The intention behind the drop-in session was to discuss the role of the practicum supervisor and to provide feedback on practicum proposal drafts.

System-Wide Projects 2020-21

System-wide projects were directed and prioritized by members of the Libraries Senior Leadership Team (SLT) as informed by the Dalhousie Libraries Bridge Strategic Plan.

System-wide projects during the summer of 2020 included: LibGuides, collections, OER resources, records management, video tutorials, research commons and research cycle website, and systematic reviews.

Summer Internships 2020 (SIM MI Students)

Due to the impact of COVID-19 the start date for summer internships was delayed. Interns worked for a period of six consecutive weeks beginning on July 6. Internships continued throughout the Fall and Winter terms.

Preparation for System-Wide Projects 2021-22

Intern Enrichment on Brightspace

The Intern Enrichment program on Brightspace remains active and includes a calendar of events and relevant documentation for each enrichment session.

In addition to Intern Enrichment content, supplemental and value-added content includes a module with links to freely available library-related webinars conferences and professional development, a multi-part series focused on decolonization education, and Dalhousie's Speak Truth to Power: Forum on Anti-Black Racism.
